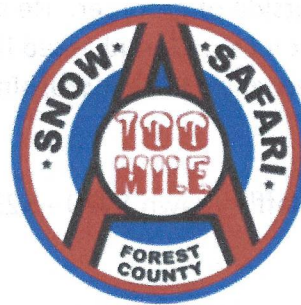


100 Mile Snow Safari

Sept 10th, 2025, Meeting Minutes

Fundraiser

We had 20 volunteers and received \$1,900 from Mark who ran the Hiles Music Festival, who split his profits with 7 organizations, which is more than expected. There are 2 – 100 square boards for guns to be raffled at the October 18th fund raiser. One at Newald Junction and one at Blue Roof. We have the \$50 raffle tickets for sale, still some left. Brushing

Ralph has been brushing for towns, making roughly \$18,500 for the club donating his time. ATV club will finish what didn't get done in April. Kat made the comment if you are on NST and the trails are not good, mention on their facebook page. Forest County did receive a grant \$30,000, which our club got some \$13,400, not as much as expected. Gerald asked about gravel and work on NST, can brushing be done, yes it can but gates are closed. Ralph will try to help with some gates if possible. Ralph asked please let him know time and equipment used to brush.

Bridges

Soper Street Bridge is done, SS6 will be open Wabeno to Armstrong Creek. Peshtigo River has a weight limit put on this summer and we cannot groom over this. Niall asked if we could still drive over. Ralph stated no the limit is too widely shared.

Member Items

Patrick shared Forest Count volunteered to host AWSC 2026 meeting in July and will need volunteers, will be doing raffles etc., also working to put a bid to host winter 2027 meeting. Chris Schaeffer from Visit Foresty County stated he would like to merge trails of ATV/Snowmobile clubs not have the argument of when snowmobile takes over vs ATV. There is a meeting in October, if anyone wants to attend, work to change some leadership. Gerald asked if money was available to fix more trails, Chris shared money is not the problem. There is for some reason more money per mile to ATV \$12,00 vs. \$9.00 snowmobile. Wayne talked him and Bill went over trails and brushing for our annual brushing day.

We would like to make sure all trails are covered. May have a sign-up sheet to ask where people want to brush. Ralph brushing day first Saturday of December, need to do better so that most of the trails get covered. Mike last year basically everyone groomed same trails. Groomers were spending too much time outside of groomer. He shared the intention is to cover everything. You will need to bring a pole saw if you can. Gerald asked if trees hanging over could be cut, Mike said yes cut it down to the stump. Mike recognized Ralph brushing on his own time, 180 hrs making the club money.
