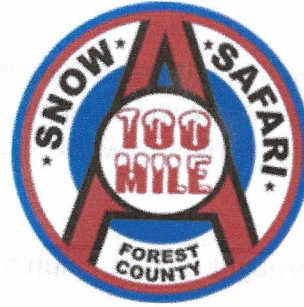


100 Mile Snow Safari
